

assassination	Glue	The murder of someone famous or important
alliance	Here	A group of countries or people who agree to work together for shared interest or aims
empire	Glue	A group of countries ruled by a single person, government or country
nationalism	HERE	Having pride in your country, willing to defend it. (Nationalism takes patriotism and adds to it a sense of superiority that calls for the conquering of the inferior.)
militarism	ONLY	Strong armed forces built to be used in order to win advantages
torpedoes	THis	Long thin bombs which travel underwater in order to destroy the ship at which it is aimed
u-boats	Column	A German Submarine, used especially in World Wars I and II
War front	Glue	A place where people are fighting in a war
trench	Here	A deep hole dug by soldiers and used to attack the enemy while being hidden.
infantry	Only	The part of an army that fights on foot
shells	Glue	A container with a pointed end, filled with explosives and shot from a large gun
Propaganda	Here	The spreading of information and ideas to advance a cause or discredit an opposing cause.
tank	Only	A large military fighting vehicle, protecting those inside, driven by wheels turning inside moving metal belts
airship	This	A large aircraft without wings, a large gas-filled bag and driven by engines
abdicate	Column	A king or queen make a formal statement that they no longer want to be king or queen
armistice	Glue	An agreement between two countries at war to stop fighting for a time, especially to talk about possible peace
neutral	Here	Not saying or doing anything that helps any of the groups involved in an argument or war
surrender	Only	To stop fighting and admit defeat
