



3RD-6TH CLASS SUPPLY LIST

This is the supply list for the upper hall only. Please read through each description carefully. IF your student is signed up for the IEW add-on class, there is an additional supply list for you to refer to.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- **1 pack of copy paper PER FAMILY** (to be turned in on first day of class)
- **Each student needs TWO separate supply boxes or bags to hold their class supplies.** Ziplock bags are acceptable. One box/bag will hold their general class supplies that will be kept at their desk and used in all classes. A separate art supply box/bag with art class-specific supplies will be brought to their desk during art class. We ask that these supplies be separated and kept in two boxes or bags to prevent taking class time to sift through or locate supplies.

Supplies to be kept in General Class Supplies Box/Bag:

- **12-count pack Elmer's Disappearing Purple Glue sticks** (Other brands do not stick well, please be sure to get the name brand, **SEE PICTURE #1**) Three glue sticks will be packed in their general supply bag and the remaining nine will be turned in to Mrs. Sonya on the first of class to be put in a box for teachers to hand out whenever a student needs a new one. These will be used weekly by three classes and we've found this is the easiest solution in making sure they always have one ready to use.
- **Two highlighters (NO YELLOW, any other colors are ok)**
- **Age-appropriate Scissors**
- **1 Ultra Fine Black Sharpie marker**
- **2 Fine Tip Black Sharpie markers** (one will go in general supplies and one in art box/bag)
- **Set of 24 Colored Pencils** (good quality brand, such as Crayola, Kingart, or Prismacolor)
- **Paper Mate Flair felt tip pens (Vivid Colors, pack of 12) (SEE PICTURE #2)** These specific markers do not bleed through paper and will be used in several classes.
- **4 Sharpened Pencils (NOT mechanical)** Pencils should be sharpened and restocked as needed so there are always four in their general supply bag.
- **2-3 Black or Blue Ink Pens**

- **1 one-inch Presentation View 3-ring binder with inside pockets (See PICTURE #3)**
- **Several sheets of loose leaf paper**

3RD-6TH SCIENCE

- **1 one-inch Presentation View 3-ring binder with inside pockets (SEE PICTURE #3)**
- **4 divider tabs**
- **1 three-hole zipper pencil pouch for binder** (will be used for holding vocabulary cards and smaller take-home items) **SEE PICTURE #4**
- **1 full-size empty Altoid (or similar) mint tin (not mini) per student** (to be turned in on first day of class)
- **Printed reading lessons and lab notebook will be provided**

3RD-6TH MATH ENRICHMENT

- 1 pocket folder with prongs (**SEE PICTURE #5**)
- 4 packs of plain, index cards (each pack is to be 100 count, not lined) These will be kept at home until specified to use.
- **Wide-ruled lined notebook paper** - they don't need a whole pack, just need to keep 5 sheets in their math folder at all times

3RD-6TH ART ENRICHMENT

- 1 spiral-bound artist sketchbook (8.5 x 11 OR 9 x 12) Must be spiral-bound so that it will lay flat AND must be one of the sizes listed so that it is large enough for art projects. Please double check the size if you are ordering it.

Supplies to be kept in Separate Art Enrichment Supplies Box/Bag: (*art pencils, markers, eraser, and sharpie may be put in a smaller pencil pouch, but all of the following list should be kept together in one main art supply ziplock bag in order to include the paints and ruler*)

- 1 Good-quality Watercolor Tray Paint Set (at least 8 colors, trays only, no tube paints) Prang, Windsor & Newton, Grabie, and Artecho are all good brand choices. NO Crayola or store brands.
- 2 Graphite Sketch or Drawing Pencils, (any two of these types are acceptable: 2H, HB, H, B, 2B, 3B), **Generals, Faber-Castell, or Prismacolor** are all good brand choices.
- 1 Ruler
- 1 set of 10 wide/broad line Crayola Markers (bright or classic colors) **SEE PICTURE #6**
- 1 Fine Tip Sharpie Marker (one for art supplies and one in general supplies)
- 1 Art Kneaded Eraser

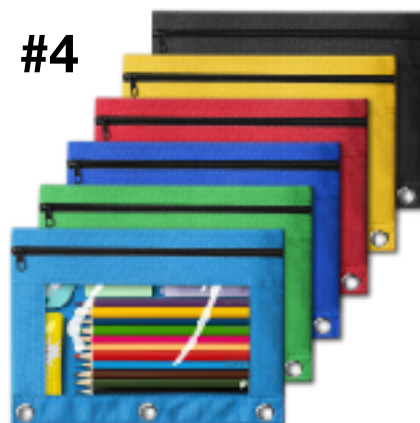
